ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

1. **NOTICE.** The ALAMEDA COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL and WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT, acting by and through its ZONE 7 WATER AGENCY (“District”) hereby gives notice that it will accept Bids for construction of the following public work:

2. **BID SUBMISSION.** District will receive sealed Bids no later than **2:00 P.M. on May 24, 2018.** District’s representative will call out the designated time in the Zone 7 office lobby, stating that the period for accepting Bids is closed. The Bid opening will be in accordance with procedures set forth in Document 00200 (Instructions to Bidders).

4. **DESCRIPTION OF THE WORK.** The Work consists of the supply of fully operated and maintained construction equipment and the furnishing of labor and material to implement project and emergency work on an as-needed basis. District anticipates that the majority of the Work will be performed during Business Hours defined in Section 01420 (References and Definitions). However, Contractor shall be available to perform District’s Work on a twenty-four hour per day, seven day per week (24/7) basis, if required. Also for emergency Work, Contractor shall respond and arrive at District sites specified by District within twelve (12) hours of District notification, to perform the Work specified by District. Contractor shall have an operation yard located within a sixty (60) mile radius of the Zone 7 North Canyons Parkway office in Livermore. Bidding Documents contain the full description of the Work. The contract is for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$1,490,000.

5. **CONTRACT TIME.** The contract will be a three year term with 3% annual bid item adjustment increases in the second and third year. During this period, the Contractor shall be available to perform Work on an on-call basis as directed by the District Representative.

6. **REQUIRED CONTRACTOR’S LICENSE(S).** Each bidder is required to have a current California Class “A” General Engineering Contractor license to bid this Contract. Joint ventures must secure a joint venture license prior to award of this Contract. Removal, handling, and/or disposal of hazardous materials may by law require hazardous substance removal certification by the Contractor’s State License Board.

PUBLIC WORKS CONTRACTOR REGISTRATION. A contractor or subcontractor shall not be qualified to bid on, be listed in a bid proposal, subject to the requirement of Section 4104 of the Public Contract Code, or engage in the performance of any contract for public work, as defined in this chapter [1770-1784 Labor Code], unless currently registered and qualified to perform public work pursuant to Section 7029.1 of the Business and Professional Code or by Section 10164 or 20103.5 of the Public Contract Code, provided the contractor is registered to perform public work pursuant to Section 1725.5 at the time the contract is awarded.

- 7. PREVAILING WAGE LAWS.** The successful Bidder must comply with all prevailing wage laws applicable to the Project, and related requirements contained in the Contract Documents. Pursuant to applicable provisions of the Labor Code, the District has implemented and shall enforce a Labor Compliance Program (LCP) for the Work. The successful Bidder shall be required to comply with all the requirements of the District's LCP and applicable provisions of the California Labor Code. In bidding on the Work, it shall be the each Bidder's responsibility to evaluate the cost of complying with the District's LCP. Bidders shall include all costs of compliance with specified requirements in their bids.
- 8. NO PRE-BID MEETING.**
- 9. SUBSTITUTION OF SECURITIES.** District will permit successful Bidder to substitute securities for retention monies withheld to ensure performance of Contract, as set forth in Document 00680 (Escrow Agreement for Security Deposits in Lieu of Retention), in accordance with California Public Contract Code, Section 22300. By this reference, Document 00680 (Escrow Agreement for Security Deposits in Lieu of Retention) is incorporated in full in this Document 00100.
- 10. PROCUREMENT OF BIDDING DOCUMENTS.** Bidders may examine Bidding Documents at the District's offices. Bidders may obtain copies of Bidding Documents upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **\$30** per set. Bidders may contact the District's main phone number at (925) 454-5000 to order Bidding Documents. District will accept cash (exact amount only), checks, or money orders payable to the "Zone 7 Water Agency." Bidding Documents need not be returned to District. A bidder must also purchase a set of the bid documents to submit a bid.
- 11. BID PREPARATION COST.** Bidders are solely responsible for the cost of preparing their Bids.
- 12. RESERVATION OF RIGHTS.** District specifically reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to reject any or all Bids, or re-bid, or to waive inconsequential deviations from Bid requirements not involving time, price, or quality of the Work.

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
