ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

1. **NOTICE.** The ALAMEDA COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL and WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT, acting by and through its ZONE 7 WATER AGENCY (“District”) hereby gives notice that it will accept Bids for construction of the following Vendor Services Contract:

2. **BID SUBMISSION.** District will receive sealed Bids no later than **2:00 P.M. on November 29, 2018, as determined by District staff by using www.time.gov**. District’s representative will call out the designated time in the Zone 7 office lobby, stating that the period for accepting Bids is closed. The Bid opening will be in accordance with procedures set forth in Document 00200 (Instructions to Bidders).

4. **DESCRIPTION OF THE WORK.** The Work consists of providing, operating, and maintaining an operational centrifuge equipment system (unmanned/automated) to mechanically dewater sludge at the Zone 7 Patterson Pass Water Treatment Plant. Contractor shall furnish all labor, materials, chemicals, equipment, services, temporary controls, and all general conditions, seismic requirements, general requirements and incidentals required to complete the Work in its entirety as described in the Contract Documents. Bidding Documents contain the full description of the Work. The estimate for this Contract is a range from \$650,000 to \$750,000 annually.
5. **REQUIRED CONTRACTOR’S LICENSE(S):** Each bidder is required to have a current California Class “A” General Engineering Contractor license to bid this Contract. Joint ventures must secure a joint venture license prior to award of this Contract. Removal, handling, and/or disposal of hazardous materials may by law require hazardous substance removal certification by the Contractor’s State License Board.

PUBLIC WORKS CONTRACTOR REGISTRATION. A contractor or subcontractor shall not be qualified to bid on, be listed in a bid proposal, subject to the requirement of Section 4104 of the Public Contract Code, or engage in the performance of any contract for public work, as defined in this chapter [1770-1784 Labor Code], unless currently registered and qualified to perform public work pursuant to Section 7029.1 of the Business and Professional Code or by Section 10164 or 20103.5 of the Public Contract Code, provided the contractor is registered to perform public work pursuant to Section 1725.5 at the time the contract is awarded.

6. **CONTRACT TIME.** The duration of the Contract shall be January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019. The contract may be extended for three (3) additional one-year periods at the District’s sole discretion. A 3% annual bid item adjustment will be allowed at the beginning of each calendar year.
7. **CONTRACTOR EXPERIENCE.** Each bidder is required to have a minimum of 5-years of experience in providing and operating similar types of mechanical dewatering systems to bid this Contract. Joint ventures must secure a joint

venture license prior to award of this Contract. Removal, handling, and/or disposal of hazardous materials may by law require hazardous substance removal certification by the Contractor's State License Board.

8. **PREVAILING WAGE LAWS.** The successful Bidder must comply with all prevailing wage laws applicable to the Project, and related requirements contained in the Contract Documents.
9. **NON-MANDATORY PRE-BID MEETING.** District will conduct a **Non-Mandatory** Pre-Bid Meeting at **2:00 P.M.** on **November 14, 2018** at the Patterson Pass Water Treatment Plant at 8750 Patterson Pass Road, Livermore, California 94550. Any Bidder wishing to investigate subsurface conditions at the Site must schedule such a visit with the District in accordance with Document 00200 (Instructions to Bidders).

11. **PROCUREMENT OF BIDDING DOCUMENTS.** Bidders may examine Bidding Documents at the District's offices. Additionally, Bidding Documents are located online at www.zone7water.com. **A Bidder is required to purchase a set of the Bidding Documents to submit a bid.** Bidders may obtain copies of Bidding Documents upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **\$10** per set. Bidders may contact the District's main phone number at (925) 454-5000 to order Bidding Documents. District will accept cash (exact amount only), checks, or money orders payable to the "Zone 7 Water Agency." Bidding Documents need not be returned to District.
12. **BID PREPARATION COST.** Bidders are solely responsible for the cost of preparing their Bids.
13. **RESERVATION OF RIGHTS.** District specifically reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to reject any or all Bids, or re-bid, or to waive inconsequential deviations from Bid requirements not involving time, price, or quality of the Work.

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
