1. NOTICE. The ALAMEDA COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL and WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT, acting by and through its ZONE 7 WATER AGENCY ("District") hereby gives notice that it will accept Bids for construction of the following public work:

- 2. BID SUBMISSION. District will receive sealed Bids no later than 2:00 p.m. on March 26, 2019, as determined by District Staff by using www.time.gov. District's representative will call out the designated time in the Zone 7 office lobby, stating that the period for accepting Bids is closed. The Bid opening will be in accordance with procedures set forth in Document 00200 (Instructions to Bidders).

- **4. DESCRIPTION OF THE WORK.** This project is to replace the civil, mechanical, and electrical components of an existing potable water supply turnout in accordance with Zone 7's Asset Management Plan. The Work for a Turnout Replacement typically consists of:
 - 1) Removal of the existing vault, mechanical piping, and electrical appurtenances of the existing turnout.
 - 2) Replacement of the vault, mechanical piping, and addition of electrical appurtenances in accordance with the approved Plans. Construction of a new turnout inlet valve is included.
 - 3) The Turnout is located in a sidewalk section near the Northwest corner of Jack London Blvd. and Arlington Rd., Livermore, CA. Due to the project being located in a City sidewalk, coordination with the City of Livermore is required. City Encroachment Permit requirements will include, but are not limited to, an approved Traffic Plan, Restricted Work Hours, and Site restoration within the work area, which will include, at minimum, Sidewalk and Curb/Gutter Replacement.

Bidding Documents contain the full description of the Work. The Engineer's estimate for this Contract is a range between \$225,000 - \$285,000.

- 5. CONTRACT TIME. Work for the CWS 5 Turnout Replacement shall be finally completed within 225 Days from the date when Contract Time commences to run. To reduce Operational Risk during High Demands, Construction will be restricted to October 1, 2019 thru April 1, 2020.
- **6. REQUIRED CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE(S).** Each bidder is required to have a current California General Engineering Contractor Class A license to bid this Contract. Joint ventures must secure a joint venture license prior to award of this Contract. Removal, handling, and/or disposal of hazardous materials may by law require hazardous substance removal certification by the Contractor's State License Board.

- 7. PREVAILING WAGE LAWS. The successful Bidder must comply with all prevailing wage laws applicable to the Project, and related requirements contained in the Contract Documents. Pursuant to applicable provisions of the Labor Code, the District has implemented and shall enforce a Labor Compliance Program (LCP) for the Work. The successful Bidder shall be required to comply with all the requirements of the District's LCP and applicable provisions of the California Labor Code. In bidding on the Work, it shall be each Bidder's responsibility to evaluate the cost of complying with the district's LCP. Bidders shall include all costs of compliance with specified requirements in their bids.
- 8. VOLUNTARY PRE-BID SITE VISIT. District will conduct a Voluntary Pre-Bid Site Visit at 10:00 a.m. on March 14, 2019 at the CWS 5 Turnout Site, Northwest corner of Jack London Blvd. and Arlington Rd., Livermore, CA 94551. Any Bidder wishing to investigate subsurface conditions at the Site must schedule such a visit with the District in accordance with Document 00200 (Instructions to Bidders).
- 9. SUBSTITUTION OF SECURITIES. District will permit successful Bidder to substitute securities for retention monies withheld to ensure performance of Contract, as set forth in Document 00680 (Escrow Agreement for Security Deposits in Lieu of Retention), in accordance with California Public Contract Code, Section 22300. By this reference, Document 00680 (Escrow Agreement for Security Deposits in Lieu of Retention) is incorporated in full in this Document 00100.
- 10. PROCUREMENT OF BIDDING DOCUMENTS. Bidders may examine Bidding Documents at the District's offices. Bidders may obtain copies of Bidding Documents upon payment of a non-refundable fee of \$35 per set. A Bidder is required to purchase a set of the Bidding Documents to submit a bid. Bidders may contact the District's main phone number at (925) 454-5000 to order Bidding Documents. District will accept cash (exact amount only), checks, or money orders payable to the "Zone 7 Water Agency." Bidding Documents need not be returned to District.
- 11. BID PREPARATION COST. Bidders are solely responsible for the cost of preparing their Bids.
- **12. RESERVATION OF RIGHTS.** District specifically reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to reject any or all Bids, or re-bid, or to waive inconsequential deviations from Bid requirements not involving time, price, or quality of the Work.
