ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

1. **NOTICE.** The ALAMEDA COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL and WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT, acting by and through its ZONE 7 WATER AGENCY (“District”) hereby gives notice that it will accept Bids for construction of the following public work:

DISTRICT PROJECT No. 276-18
Chain of Lakes (COL) 1 Well Facility Stabilization Project

2. **BID SUBMISSION.** District will receive sealed Bids no later than **2:00pm on Tuesday, April 23, 2019**. District’s representative will call out the designated time in the Zone 7 office lobby, stating that the period for accepting Bids is closed. The Bid opening will be in accordance with procedures set forth in Document 00200 (Instructions to Bidders).

4. **DESCRIPTION OF THE WORK.** The Work consists of 1) installing micro piles inside and around the perimeter of the well building in varying depths ranging from 45 feet to 80 feet with pile caps tying into the building footings for underpinning to support the foundation against future settlement, 2) installing cast-in-drilled-hole (CIDH) piles, 30-inches in diameter, to a depth of 30 to 40 feet connecting them by horizontal tie beam to the foundation to support against future lateral movement, 3) injecting grout at selected locations underneath the building foundations to fill in any potential voids and 4) other work including, but not limited to, associated demolition and disposal work, removal and replacement of equipment conflicting with pile locations, installation of inclinometers, concrete and aggregate base work. The Engineer’s estimate for this Contract is approximately \$2,000,000.
5. **CONTRACT TIME.** Work shall be finally completed within **200** Days from the date when Contract Time commences to run.
6. **REQUIRED CONTRACTOR’S LICENSE(S).** Each bidder is required to have a current California Class A - General Engineering Contractor license to bid this Contract. Joint ventures must secure a joint venture license prior to award of this Contract. Removal, handling, and/or disposal of hazardous materials may by law require hazardous substance removal certification by the Contractor’s State License Board.

PUBLIC WORKS CONTRACTOR REGISTRATION. A contractor or subcontractor shall not be qualified to bid on, be listed in a bid proposal, subject to the requirement of Section 4104 of the Public Contract Code, or engage in the performance of any contract for public work, as defined in this chapter [1770-1784 Labor Code], unless currently registered and qualified to perform public work pursuant to Section 7029.1 of the Business and Professional Code or by Section 10164 or 20103.5 of the Public Contract Code, provided the contractor is registered to perform public work pursuant to Section 1725.5 at the time the contract is awarded.

PREVAILING WAGE LAWS. The successful Bidder must comply with all prevailing wage laws applicable to the Project, and related requirements contained in the Contract Documents.

MANDATORY PRE-BID SITE VISIT. District will conduct a Mandatory Pre-Bid Site Visit at **10:30 am on Thursday, April 11, 2019** at the District Office 100 North Canyons Parkway, Livermore, CA 94551.

7. **SUBSTITUTION OF SECURITIES.** District will permit successful Bidder to substitute securities for retention monies withheld to ensure performance of Contract, as set forth in Document 00680 (Escrow Agreement for Security Deposits in Lieu of Retention), in accordance with California Public Contract Code, Section 22300. By this reference, Document 00680 (Escrow Agreement for Security Deposits in Lieu of Retention) is incorporated in full in this Document 00100.
8. **PROCUREMENT OF BIDDING DOCUMENTS.** Bidders may examine Bidding Documents at the District's offices. Additionally, Bidding Documents are located online at www.zone7water.com. **A Bidder is required to purchase a set of the Bidding Documents to submit a bid.** Bidders may obtain copies of Bidding Documents upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **\$25** per set. Bidders may contact the District's main phone number at (925) 454-5000 to order Bidding Documents. District will accept cash (exact amount only), checks, or money orders payable to the "Zone 7 Water Agency." Bidding Documents need not be returned to District.
9. **BID PREPARATION COST.** Bidders are solely responsible for the cost of preparing their Bids.
10. **RESERVATION OF RIGHTS.** District specifically reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to reject any or all Bids, or re-bid, or to waive inconsequential deviations from Bid requirements not involving time, price, or quality of the Work.

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
