ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

1. NOTICE. The ALAMEDA COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL and WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT, acting by and through its ZONE 7 WATER AGENCY ("District") hereby gives notice that it will accept Bids for construction of the following public work:

ALAMO CREEK BANK STABILIZATION AND FLOOD MANAGEMENT PILOT PROJECT - DUBLIN, CALIFORNIA PROJECT No. 306-24

- **2. BID SUBMISSION.** District will receive sealed Bids at District's Main Office at 100 North Canyons Parkway, Livermore, CA 94551, no later than 2:00 P.M. on Thursday, May 8, 2025, as determined by District staff by using www.time.gov. District will set up a Bid Box at the front desk. The Bid Box will be available to deposit bids starting at 12:30 P.M. on the day of the Bid Opening and will be removed promptly at 2:00 P.M. The Bid Box will be monitored by District staff. Bid opening will take place in-person in the Board Room of the District's Main Office. The Bid opening will be in accordance with procedures set forth in Document 00200 (Instructions to Bidders) and as modified in Document 00800 (Supplementary Conditions Division 0).

DESCRIPTION OF THE WORK. The Work consists of constructing eight (8) channel modules designed to stabilize eroded banks, through the installation of vegetated soil lifts, vegetated rock slope protection, rock cross vanes, erosion control, willow stakes, and planting along an approximate 2000' reach of Alamo Creek in Dublin, California, downstream of the South San Ramon Creek-Alamo Creek confluence. Five (5) of the modules are subject to a CA Department of Water Resources (DWR) Floodplain Management, Protection, and Risk Awareness Grant, while the remaining three (3) are subject to Federal Emergency Management Agency Public Assistance funding, which will require tracking expenditures separately.

Contractor shall furnish and install all material as specified in the Contract Documents. Bidding Documents contain the full description of the Work. The Engineer's estimate for the Project is \$5,600,000.

4. CONTRACT TIME. All heavy equipment in-channel work may be performed during the construction season of June 1, 2025 - October 15, 2025, or as directed by the Project Engineer. Final Completion of this Project shall be completed by December 16, 2025. The Contract Time shall be the Days from the District's Notice to Proceed (NTP) to the Contractor to the Final Completion Date of December 16, 2025.

NTP for this project is subject to receipt of all regulatory permits. The Contractor shall not commence work until the NTP is issued.

Zone 7 will not be responsible for any costs, including but not limited to mobilization, demobilization, standby time, or other delays, resulting from the permitting process or the timing of the NTP issuance.

5. REQUIRED CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE(S). Each bidder is required to have a valid and current California Class A — General Engineering license to bid this Contract. Joint ventures must secure a joint venture license prior to award of this Contract. Removal, handling, and/or disposal of hazardous materials may by law require hazardous substance removal certification by the Contractor's State License Board.

PUBLIC WORKS CONTRACTOR REGISTRATION. A contractor or subcontractor shall not be qualified to bid on, be listed in a bid proposal, subject to the requirement of Section 4104 of the Public Contract Code, or engage in the performance of any contract for public work, as defined in this chapter [1770-1784 Labor Code], unless currently registered and qualified to perform public work pursuant to Section 7029.1 of the Business and Professional Code or by Section 10164 or 20103.5 of the Public Contract Code, provided the contractor is registered to perform public work pursuant to Labor Code Section 1725.5 at the time the contract is awarded.

REQUIRED MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS. A Contractor or subcontractor shall have the minimum qualifications to perform the work as described in Section 00450 (Statement of Qualifications for Construction Work).

6. PREVAILING WAGE LAWS. The successful Bidder must comply with all prevailing wage laws applicable to the Project, and related requirements contained in the Contract Documents. Pursuant to applicable provisions of the Labor Code, the District has implemented and shall enforce a Labor Compliance Program (LCP) for the Work. The successful Bidder shall be required to comply with all the

requirements of the District's LCP and applicable provisions of the California Labor Code. In bidding on the Work, it shall be each Bidder's responsibility to evaluate the cost of complying with the District's LCP. Bidders shall include all costs of compliance with specified requirements in their bids.

7. MANDATORY PRE-BID MEETING AND SITE VISIT. District will conduct a Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting and Site Visit beginning at 10:00 A.M. on Thursday, April 17, 2025 at 5997 Parkside Drive, Pleasanton, CA 94588 and then to the Site. Any Bidder wishing to investigate subsurface conditions at the Site must schedule such a visit with the District in accordance with Document 00200 (Instructions to Bidders). Attendance at the Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting and Site Visit will be taken. If a Bidder fails to attend the Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting and Site Visit as required, District reserves the right to reject the Bid as non-responsive.

Requests for Information are due at 2:00 P.M. on Thursday, April 24, 2025. The District will respond to all questions, via written response or addenda, by 2:00 P.M. on Thursday, May 1, 2025 via posting on District's website and an email sent to those on the registered Planholders' List.

- **8. SUBSTITUTION OF SECURITIES.** District will permit successful Bidder to substitute securities for retention monies withheld to ensure performance of Contract, as set forth in Document 00680 (Escrow Agreement for Security Deposits in Lieu of Retention), in accordance with California Public Contract Code, Section 22300. By this reference, Document 00680 (Escrow Agreement for Security Deposits in Lieu of Retention) is incorporated in full in this Document 00100.
- 9. PROCUREMENT OF BIDDING DOCUMENTS. Bidding Documents are located online at www.zone7water.com under Construction & Business Opportunities Opportunities or Solicitations outside of the OpenGov Portal section, where Bidders may download copies for no fee. Bidders must complete the web form to download the Bidding Documents (Drawings and Specifications) from District's website to be put on the Planholder's List. If a Bidder fails to be put on the Planholder's List as required, the District reserve the right to reject the Bid as non-responsive.
- **10.BID PREPARATION COST.** Bidders are solely responsible for the cost of preparing their Bids.
- **11.RESERVATION OF RIGHTS.** District specifically reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to reject any or all Bids, or re-bid, or to waive inconsequential deviations from Bid requirements.

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
