### SECTION 02240 TEMPORARY WATER DIVERSION

#### **PART 1 - GENERAL REQUIREMENTS**

#### 1.01 SCOPE OF WORK

A. The work to be performed under this Section shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials, tools, transportation, supplies, equipment, appurtenances, fuel, and power, unless specifically excepted, necessary or required for any dewatering work required or as shown on the plans and described in these specifications. Work shall be in conformance to Caltrans standard specs Section 13 "Water Pollution Control".

#### 1.02 DESCRIPTION OF WORK

- A. Water diversion will be implemented by the Contractor to maintain the work site as water-free as possible for the duration of in-channel work.
- B. Contractor shall utilize a temporary water diversion within the existing flood control channels using either
  - 1. Cofferdams at the upstream and downstream limits and bypass piping and/or pumps.
  - 2. Berms / Cofferdams to confine flow to one side of the channel, so work can occur at the toe of slope.

Dewatering shall be designed to minimize environmental impacts to the extent feasible. Dewatering shall be designed such that it does not cause damage or additional erosion or sedimentation to the surrounding channel.

#### PART 2 - CONSTRUCTION

#### 2.01 COFFERDAMS

A. For the purpose of this work, cofferdam shall be understood to mean any temporary type construction to satisfy the condition that all creek restoration work is to be done in the dry.
