
Takeaways

- Annual reconciliation process is in place to ensure equitability between the untreated and treated customers.
- 2. Progress has been made on the Untreated Water Program's outstanding reconciliation balance.
- 3. Board approved a five-year phase-in to continue progress towards goal of collecting outstanding balance within in a reasonable timeframe.




Background/Objectives

- Agency implemented annual reconciliation process for the following reasons:
 - Rates are set annually and based on cost and delivery projections
 - Untreated Water Program does not have a designated fund balance
- Objectives of the annual reconciliation include:
 - Sufficient revenues are collected to meet costs
 - Establish equity between treated and untreated water customers





Historical Reconciliation Charges/Credits



Results of CY 2023 Reconciliation

Reconciliation calculated using cash flow analysis



- Outstanding reconciliation balance **reduced** by \$304,392.
- Balance as of December 2023 = \$1,108,165




How do we continue to make progress?





Outstanding/Projected Reconciliation Balance




Upcoming Meetings/Next Steps
